<u>Private Tutorial-Original Course Instruction</u>: Forty-five (45) hours of individual tutoring will permit a student to meet the requirements for a course. However, to meet course requirements, the student must pass a district departmental final examination, as approved by the principal, for the course. The final examination must be taken on school district property under the supervision of an administrator or certified professional employee of the district. Payment for this type of instruction is the responsibility of the student.

Only two graduation credits may be earned through a tutorial original instruction program.
