- Program Alternatives:

 - LCTI Academic Center – academic classes taken at LCTI – student will spend ½ day in LCTI Lab and ½ day at LCTI in academic courses (full day at LCTI – See your counselor)
 - CAP Program – an all day LCTI alternative program at LCTI – See your counselor
 - D.C.O. Program – students choose to attend CHS for ½ day and work for ½ day – See your counselor
 - Flex Program – An LCTI course designed for Honors/CP students to offer hands-on technical lab experiences
